SNAP Benefits: Helping Harvest Fresh Food Bank is happy to assist residents of Berks and Schuylkill counties in applying for SNAP benefits. Applications can be completed over the phone or in-person, based on individual needs. Helping Harvest's SNAP Outreach team will walk individuals and families through the application process step by step and will provide follow up after submission.
