EXISTING RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE REPLACEMENT, ADDITION OR ASSOCIATED STRUCTURES

BCALP Guideline Language:

Replacement or modification of an existing residential structure can occur within the existing curtilage <u>after</u> BCALP Board acknowledgement.

Associated personal use structures may be constructed within the existing curtilage <u>after BCALP Board</u> Acknowledgement.

<u>DETAILS</u>

- Deed of Easement (DOE) defines curtilage as the area surrounding the residential structure used for a yard, driveway, on lot sewage system, or other nonagricultural purposes.
- The replacement of a residential structure existing on the eased land on the date of the granting of the easement is permitted if the preexisting structure is razed or removed and the replacement residential structure is erected within the curtilage of the residential structure it replaces.
- All associated structures must be constructed within the curtilage and include but not limited to the following: Garages, Swimming Pools, Garden sheds, Solar panels, Outdoor furnaces and Water gardens.
- If the residential replacement structure requires a new septic system that must be located outside the curtilage into agriculture areas, a request for relief must be made to the BCLPB.

<u>STEPS</u>

- \Rightarrow Request Easement Modification Form be mailed or emailed.
- \Rightarrow Review the Curtilage Agreement
- \Rightarrow Use the enclosed aerial photo to identify the location of the structure and include:

____ On-lot septic system

_____ Access/driveway to structure

_____ Outline of planned yard area

- \Rightarrow Provide Municipal acknowledgement and/or approval or explanation of status.
- \Rightarrow Complete the Easement Modification Form in detail
- \Rightarrow Confirm all ACE Landowners sign and date the Easement Modification Form
- ⇒ Submit the Easement Modification Form with drawings and supporting documents to the Berks County Department of Agriculture office for Review and BCALP Board acknowledgment.

Construction should not begin before Approval letter received from BCALP Board.
